

CALL FOR PARTNER

Deadline for initial call: 30th September 2016

PROGRAM: PO WER – 4.3. transnational cooperation, Knowledge Education Development

The aim of the project is to develop and implement in Poland new solutions, created in cooperation with foreign partners in the area of:

1. Aligning the access to formal and non-formal life long learning process of all ages, raise awareness, improve the skills and competences of the workforce and promoting flexible learning pathways, including through career counseling and validation of acquired competences,
2. Better adaptation of education and training systems to labor market needs, facilitating transition from education to employment and the strengthening of education and training and their quality, including through mechanisms of forecasting skills, to adapt curricula and the creation or development of systems of learning through apprenticeship and implemented in close cooperation with employers,

Duration of the project: 24 months

Partner:

Eligible countries: EU Member States.

We are looking for 1-2 partners with experience in working on area mentioned above (1 or/and 2). The idea of this project is to use good practises from EU Partners and adapt them into Polish environment. We are looking for Partner interested in sharing experience of work based on innovative, corresponding with actual knowledge.

Partner's role in project:

Project assumes following activities:

- 1) transfer, adaptation and implementation of good practices from foreign partners in Poland, or
- 2) parallel creation and implementation of new solutions, and
- 3) exchange of information and good practices.

Possible action: workshops, seminars, meetings of experts, creation of forums for exchanging opinions, research and analysis.

Finances:

All Partners should submit the same project in their country within the Common Framework – ESF covered only national costs for each Partner. Partners can also participate in project without budget, as essential partner.

Required information:

- description of the good practises that can be used in the project's topic,
- description of the partner,
- experience in field / subject of the project;
- experience of staff working in partner organisation,
- experience in international projects (not obligatory).
